### *Update on Adult Day Care and Senior Center Operations*

Hagåtña, Guam – The Division of Senior Citizens (DSC) of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) provides the following update on Adult Day Care and Senior Center operations following Typhoon Sinlaku.

As recovery efforts continue, services are being adjusted to maintain access to care while utility restoration is still in progress.

#### **Adult Day Care Services**

Adult Day Care Services (ADC) will operate beginning Monday, April 20, 2026, at the following locations:

- ADC Dementia Wusstig Facility
- ADC South

ADC Central (Macheche) remains without power at this time. Families have been informed of a temporary relocation to continue services.

#### **Senior Centers**

Senior Centers remain closed at this time. Centers will reopen as soon as power and water are restored. Updates will be provided as they become available.

#### **Congregate Meal Services**

Beginning Monday, April 20, 2026, congregate hot meals will be provided through Grab and Go service at designated centers for seniors with access to a privately owned vehicle. Seniors who rely on Title III transportation services will receive home delivered meals until normal center operations resume.

These adjustments support continued access to services during typhoon recovery.
