Urgent Food Commodity Distribution for Typhoon-Affected Households

Hagåtña, Guam – The Division of Homelessness Assistance and Poverty Prevention (DHAPP) of the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), is actively deploying food commodity distributions across multiple locations this week to reach households impacted by storm-related food loss following Typhoon Sinlaku.

Food assistance is prioritized for households affected by food loss, including those receiving SNAP, Medicaid, MIP, or with limited resources. DPHSS will make every effort to serve those in need.

Food assistance will be available at the following locations:

- **Thursday, April 23, 2026**
Adelup Breezeway
9:00 a.m. to 12 p.m.
Drive-through distribution
- **Friday, April 24, 2026**
Micronesia Mall (Sinlaku Recovery: DPHSS In Action outreach event providing FREE medical care, immunizations, and food support)
10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
Walk-up distribution
- **Friday, April 24, 2026**
Northern Region Community Health Center (NRCHC), Dededo
3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.
Drive-through distribution

This week's distributions are part of an accelerated recovery effort to reach households still facing food loss following the storm. Community members who are unable to attend Thursday's distribution are encouraged to access the final two distribution opportunities scheduled on Friday.

Individuals may be asked to provide identification and must complete a brief form to confirm household eligibility at the time of distribution. Households experiencing need are encouraged to attend. Supplies are limited and will be distributed while available.

DPHSS continues to actively mobilize services across the island to meet urgent needs and restore access to essential support during this critical recovery period.
