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Get Immunized Guam! Keep Your Loved Ones Safe: Protect Your Family Against Pertussis (Whooping Cough)

Hagåtña, Guam – In response to the recently confirmed 12th and 13th pertussis cases, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) will conduct a **FREE Pertussis immunization clinic** for children and adults on **May 13, 2026**. The one-day clinic will provide critical pertussis vaccinations for eligible individuals.

Pertussis Immunization Outreach Clinic

- Date: May 13, 2026
- Time: 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. (or while supplies last)
- Location: Barrigada Mayor's Office
- Eligibility: Individuals 2 months and older, regardless of health insurance
- Available Vaccines:
 - DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis) vaccination for infants and young children.
 - Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccination for adolescents and adults

Requirements:

- Children under 18 years of age:
 - Child's current shot record (yellow shot card)
 - Must be accompanied by a parent. If accompanied by another adult, legal documentation or written authorization from the parent is required.
 - Child's birth certificate
 - Parent, guardian, or authorized adult's valid photo ID
- Adults must bring a photo ID and a current shot record (yellow shot card), if available

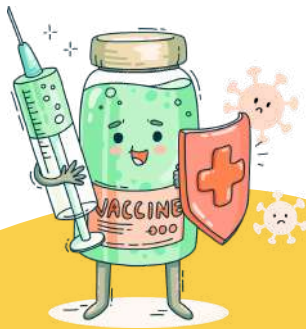

REQUIREMENTS:

- Adults must bring a photo ID and a current shot record (if available).
- Individuals with physical disabilities or use walking aids such as canes, crutches, or walkers will be moved to the front of the line.
- Proof of physical disability must be provided for this accommodation.
- Child's current shot record (Yellow Shot Card)
- Children below 18 years of age:
 - Must be accompanied by a parent. If other than parent, adult must have legal documents or written authorization from parent.
 - Child's Birth Certificate
 - Parent, guardian or authorized adult's photo ID.
