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**Get Immunized Guam! Safeguard Your Home Against Pertussis (Whooping Cough)**

Hagåtña, Guam – In response to the ongoing pertussis outbreak, the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) will continue offering **FREE Pertussis immunization clinics** for children and adults, across multiple villages in May 2026. Additional clinic dates have been added to increase access to vaccinations across the island, regardless of health insurance coverage.

The May 23 and May 30 outreach clinics are offered in partnership with the Guam Community Health Centers' Back-to-School In-Reach initiative, which supports families in preparing for the upcoming school year. Eligibility: Individuals 2 months and older, including expectant moms (between 27-36 weeks gestation) and dads. Regardless of health insurance.

Available Vaccines:

- DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus, acellular pertussis) vaccination for infants and young children
- Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccination for adolescents and adults
- Influenza for adults, limited stock

Requirements:

- Children under 18 years of age:
  - Child's current shot record (yellow shot card)
  - Child's birth certificate
  - Must be accompanied by a parent. If accompanied by another adult, legal documentation or written authorization from parent is required.
  - Parent, guardian, or authorized adult's photo ID.
- Adults must bring a photo ID and a current shot record (yellow shot card), if available
