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DPHSS Launches Modernized Website Designed Around the Needs of the People of Guam

Hagåtña, Guam – The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) will officially launch its newly redesigned website on **July 1, 2026**, marking a major step forward in the department's continued modernization efforts to improve how the people of Guam access public health and social services information online.

For years, residents have voiced frustrations navigating outdated systems and searching for important public information online. The launch of the new DPHSS website reflects a significant transformation in how the department connects the community to services, programs, updates, and emergency information.

The redesigned website reflects the modernization vision of DPHSS Director Theresa C. Arriola, with continued support from Governor Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero and Lieutenant Governor Joshua F. Tenorio to improve accessibility, strengthen communication, and modernize the public experience across government services.

The updated website includes:

- Mobile friendly access for smartphones and tablets
- Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant accessibility features
- Automated website translation support for multiple languages
- Easier navigation across DPHSS divisions, programs, and services
- Simplified access to forms, resources, and commonly requested information
- Improved visibility of public health advisories and community updates
- Enhanced user experience for residents accessing services online

For many individuals and families, a mobile device is now their primary connection to information and services. The redesigned website was developed with that reality in mind while also recognizing the importance of accessibility for elderly residents, individuals with disabilities, caregivers, and community members navigating critical services during vulnerable moments in their lives.

"This launch represents more than a new website," said DPHSS Director Theresa C. Arriola. "It reflects our continued efforts to modernize the way people connect to services, information, and support. Accessing public resources should feel easier to navigate, more accessible, and more connected to the everyday needs of our community."

The Department encourages the community to explore the updated website beginning July 1, 2026 and continue following DPHSS for public health updates, services, programs, and emergency information.
