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DPHSS Maintains WIC Services with Expanded Inalåhan Clinic Hours During Santa Rita Closure

Participants may visit any WIC clinic during the temporary closure.

Hagåtña, Guam – The Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS) advises the public that the Santa Rita Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Clinic will remain temporarily closed until further notice due to continued power issues.

Expanded Inalåhan WIC Clinic Hours

Effective immediately, the Inalåhan WIC Clinic, located at the Southern Region Community Health Center, 162 As Apman Drive, Inalåhan, will operate:

Monday through Friday

8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

Closed on Government of Guam holidays and the last Friday of each month.

The expanded schedule replaces the clinic's previous Tuesday and Thursday service days and is intended to accommodate participants normally served by the Santa Rita WIC Clinic.

WIC Services Remain Available Island-wide

DPHSS reminds participants that WIC services remain available at all Northern, Central, and Southern WIC clinics through the program's "No Wrong Door" policy.

Who Can Receive WIC Services

The WIC Program provides supplementation nutritious foods, nutrition education, breastfeeding support, and healthcare referrals for eligible:

- Low-income pregnant women
- Breastfeeding women
- Non-breastfeeding postpartum woman
- Infants
- Children up to five (5) years of age who are at nutritional risk
